STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT - SPORT

Student involvement in interschool sports events is dependent on student's consistent adherence to school expectations and alignment with the school's core values. Interschool sports, being an extracurricular activity, is subject to the school's discretion in permitting student participation. The school reserves the authority to withdraw or suspend players/teams from sporting competitions and interschool sports rounds if these expectations are not upheld, as well as face further disciplinary action if deemed required by the school.

As a representative of Rochedale SHS:

- ✓ Students will demonstrate respect towards staff, fellow students, and opposing teams/players, upholding the integrity of the interschool sporting program.
- ✓ Students will follow teacher direction to allow for a safe and productive environment for all.
- ✓ Students will take responsibility for meeting team obligations, such as punctuality for games, consistent attendance, and approaching all tasks with a sense of pride.
- ✓ Students will acknowledge and accept the decisions made by the coaching staff, including those related to selection, playing time, and positions.

Failure to meet this student code of conduct at either an individual or team level may result in:

- 1. Suspension from games
- 2. Removal from competitions/events or interschool sport season

Note:

Action taken will be at the discretion of the school including the duration of any suspension/removals implemented. Students will not be re-imbursed for any fees associated with removal from events/sporting seasons due to failure to meet these expectations.
