- Develop the social-emotional intelligence capacity of the Junior and Middle phase learners
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Our initiatives include

- The implementation of Year 8 BYOD program and the blended pedagogical approach with eLearning
- Introduction and implementation of a whole school *WRAP* pastoral care program
- The continuation of Foundation, Core and Extension options for Literacy and Numeracy classes
- The continuation of a suite of programs to support students along the full continuum of learning: Master classes, Corrective Reading, UNIFY projects, Athletics and Gifted and Talented options
- The continued employment of the Youth Support Engagement Officer and Industry Liaison officer to enrich pathway options
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Our school will improve student outcomes by

- The employment of an E-learning HOD and Student welfare HOD to lead the implementation and facilitation of key strategic annual implementations (\$55,000)
- Master Classes (\$12,000)
- Employment of staff to support Corrective Reading, Foundation Maths and English classes (\$282,950)
- Participation of high achieving students in IMPACT programs (\$14,000)
- Employment of a Youth Support co-ordinator (intervention strategies) and Industry Liaison Officer (alternate pathways) (\$76,000)



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
