

	Corrective Reading - 100% of student attain their chronological reading age in year 7.	
	Jac Plus - Support seamless transition to remote learning; Access to anytime, anywhere learning.	
	Collegial Engagement in staff professional growth – 100% of staff use High Impact Teaching strategies as outlined in the new Teaching and Learning framework.
